As Executive Vice President, Gas Transportation & International, Steve has overall responsibility for Enbridge Energy Partners and for all of Enbridge's natural gas operations, including the Alliance and Vector natural gas pipelines. He also oversees Enbridge Gas Distribution, Canada's largest Gas Distribution company and is responsible for the International business unit, including Enbridge Technology Inc.

Steve joined Enbridge as President and Chief Operating Officer of Energy Services in 1999, and was appointed Group Vice-President, Distribution and Services in 2001. Before coming to Enbridge, Steve held senior executive positions with a number of companies in the energy transmission, exploration and production sectors.

He serves as Patron for UNICEF Alberta, was a Director of YMCA Calgary, was on the Board of Governors at McMaster University and is an Honorary Director of Westpark Hospital in Toronto.
